Bonarda dell'Oltrepò Pavese DOC

A symbol of local winemaking, it is obtained from the single-variety vinification of Croatina grapes.

This single-varietal wine comes from land that has always belonged to our family, located in the eponymous Bosco Longhino: it was with this wine that great-great-grandfather Edoardo began his winemaking activity.

Color: deep ruby red with violet reflections.

Aromas: fine, intense, penetrating and vinous, with hints of wild cherry and blackberry.

Taste: spirited body, lightly tannic, with medium-long persistence.

Food pairings: best enjoyed in its youth, freely paired with any refined gastronomic preparation, above all braised meat ravioli.

Serving temperature: 15° C

Alcohol content: 13% vol.
